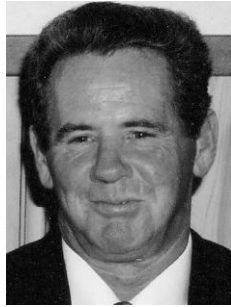


James Allen (Jimmy) MacMullin, 69
