


LAURENCE WALTER "STEWART"



Walter Stewart Laurence

September 5, 1932 - November 3, 2021 (Aged 89)

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Walter "Stewart" Laurence, formally of Margaree Harbour on November 3, 2021 at Valley Regional Hospital in Kentville, NS.

Stewart was the eldest son of Hastings and Violet (Cassidy) Laurence. After graduating from King's College (now known as King's-Edgehill) in

Windsor, NS, Stew attended the Land Survey Institute in Lawrencetown, NS. Shortly after, he joined the military and assisted in building the expansion of CFB Wainwright. After a stint in the military, Stewart returned to Nova Scotia and got a job as a Land Surveyor for the NS Department of Transportation. While living in Windsor, he met his true love Joan MacLean, married, and settled in Windsor where they raised their two children Paul and Patricia. After 30 years with the Department of Transportation, he and Joan moved to Margaree where he retired shortly thereafter.

Stewart was an active member of the community and loved being around people. He sat as a Boy Scout Leader in Windsor for 20+ years, sat on numerous committees for the Calvin United Church in Margaree, was a member of the Cape Breton Housing Authority, and spent a number of years as the Harbour Master in Belle Cote.

Stewart loved driving and could be seen “running the roads” between ‘the Forks’ and ‘the Harbour every day. He knew every back road in Nova Scotia and every short cut (and long way around!), having built a number of the roads that he travelled on. He was known for having quite a lead foot but was the first person to tell you that he had never received a speeding ticket.

He was a loving and devoted grandfather to Lucinda, James, and Ashley, and great-grandfather to Alina and Alexander.

Stewart will be remembered for his sense of humor, his stories (some tall tales too!), and dedication to his family and friends.

Stewart is predeceased by his wife Joan, daughter Patricia, parents Hastings and Violet, brother Clifford, and an infant sister. He leaves behind son Paul (Linda), grandchildren Lucinda (Michael), James, and Ashley (Bradley), great-grandchildren Alina and Alexander, brothers Fletcher (Sandra) and Gordon (Beverley), several nieces and nephews, and countless friends.

Memorial service for Stewart and his daughter Patricia who passed away September 21, 2021 will be held at Calvin United Church in Margaree Harbour at 11 a.m. on November 10, 2021. Burial to take place shortly after at Whale Cove Cemetery. Memorial Service will be open to the public with capacity limits in place. Proof of vaccination and ID is required and masks are mandatory.
