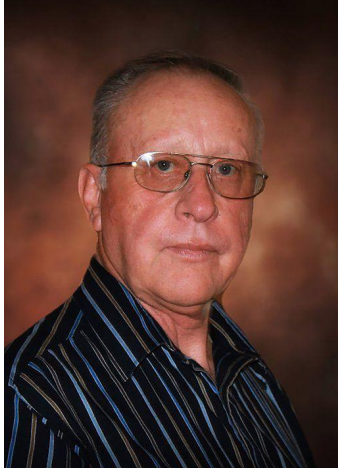


Lorne Ainslie MacDonald
