Carmichael - Murdoch Benjamin, age 100 passed away peacefully at the Inverary Manor on March 27th, 2024 surrounded by family. Murdoch spent most of his early years in the lumber industry and later became the post master of the Margaree Valley Post Office until his retirement.

His retirement was spent mowing lawns, splitting wood, gardening, doing odd jobs to help his family and drinking tea by the wood fire.
